Format:

There will be four 5 team pools. For the 5 team pools, the reffing team will need to ref both courts in the pool. There will be a 20-minute lunch break after round 3 of the pools. All pools will play 2 sets to 25 with a 27-point cap per match. The top 2 teams in each pool advance to the Gold. 3rd & 4th place teams will play in the silver bracket. 5th Place teams will go to a bronze bracket. Gold and Silver playoffs are pre-seeded based on the outcome of the pool. The bracket will be up at tournament central. All playoff matches will be best of 3 with no cap. Tiebreakers in pool play will be head-to-head, pool play game % (3 Way Tie), pool play point differential, and coin toss.

The coaches meeting will take place in the lobby at 8:40 to give the schedule for the playoffs. Any questions about format or seeding can be sent to vince@mielite.com.
